I was elected Vice-President. Bishop Lionel Gendron (St-Jean-Longueuil) and Archbishop Anthony Mancini (Halifax-Yarmouth) were elected Co-Treasures. The Plenary Assembly concludes at noon today. ARCHBISHOP PEDRO LOPEZ QUINTANA, APOSTOLIC NUNCIO to Canada was feted during the CCCB Plenary Assembly on Monday evening. Pope Francis has called him to Rome following four years of service as Nuncio. He leaves tomorrow. Monsignor Maurizio Bravi, Counsellor at the Nunciature, will be the principal contact person there until a new Nuncio is named.

CONTRIBUTIONS APPROACHING \$160,000 from parishioners in the Diocese of Hamilton, supported the special collection sponsored by the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace to assist refugees from Syria. To date over \$800,000 has been collected. The Federal Government has provided over \$5 million to the important work. Thanks to all who contributed!
