MERCY BEGETS MERCY WAS THE CENTRAL THEME of a stirring reflection by Bishop Daniel Miehm to Priests who serve in Hamilton Diocese. He went on to teach that "the best way to be a good confessor is to be a good penitent! ... A frequent encounter with the Lord's mercy keeps us on track." The first Day of Prayer was held on Tuesday at the Cathedral Basilica in Hamilton. The second was held at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish in Waterloo. OVER 100 OF THE ELECT WERE WELCOMED IN TWO CEREMONIES at the Rite of Election last Sunday. The ritual was held in two venues, St. Michael's Parish in Waterloo for the "northern" Deaneries, and the Cathedral Basilica in Hamilton for the "southern" Deaneries. The powerful events were joyful and deeply moving for those who are preparing for the Sacraments of Initiation, for their Godparents and families, and for everyone who was present for the event.
