THE CANADIAN BISHOP-PARTICIPANTS AT THE ORDINARY SYNOD ON THE FAMILY in October were formally announced by Pope Francis earlier this week. Cardinal Thomas Collins (Toronto) and Archbishop Richard Smith (Edmonton) were chosen from the English-Sector, with Archbishop Michael Miller (Vancouver) as substitute. Archbishop Paul-André Durocher (Gatineau) and Bishop Noel Simard (Valleyfield) were chosen from the French-Sector, with Bishop Lionel Gendron (St. Jean-Longueuil) as substitute. It is expected that lay experts will be chosen in the coming weeks.

THE FORMAL CELEBRATION FOR BASILICA STATUS, the honour given to the Church of Our Lady Immaculate, Guelph, last December 8th, takes place on **June 29th**, Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, at 7 p.m. The ceremony involves the reception of the *Ombrellino* (umbrella) and *Tintinnabulum* (bell), and a new Coat-of-Arms, all signs of Basilica status. May this honour provide special graces to parishioners and visitors alike.
