The honour is conferred in recognition of his leadership of the Diocese of Hamilton for 27 years, and his dedication to Catholic education and to the University. We offer our congratulations to Bishop Tonnos on this well-deserved honour!

AND WE EXTEND CONGRATULATIONS TO MONSIGNOR HARVEY ROACH, on his appointment by Pope Benedict XVI as Protonotary Apostolic; to Monsignor Edward Sheridan, V.G. who was appointed Prelate of Honour, and Monsignor Edward House, who was appointed Chaplain of His Holiness. All three priests of our Diocese are very worthy recipients. The investiture will take place at the 5 p.m. Mass on Saturday, May 14, at the Cathedral of Christ the King.
