ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA PARISH will be the new Parish on Hamilton Mountain. The Decree, dated March 25, 2017, the Feast of the Annunciation, patronal feast of the Diocese, also defined the boundaries of the new Parish and announced that Father Mark Gatto will be the founding Pastor. The new reality will be effective, June 28, 2017. A second Decree establishes new boundaries for the other Parishes on the mountain to accommodate the new Parish and to reflect the population growth and other changes on the mountain over the years.

Year One candidates will be learning about the Psalms from Sr. Eileen Schuller, OSU, and Wisdom Literature from Deacon Peter Gittens. Year Three candidates will be focusing on Homiletics. Sister Immolatia in Corde Perforato Iesu, pjc, will present to both groups on ministry to the poor and marginalized. Father David Wynen, Spiritual Director to the program, will celebrate the Mass.
