**THE CONGREGATION FOR DIVINE WORSHIP** and Discipline of the Sacraments has issued a Decree inscribing the *Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church*, in the General Roman Calendar. The Decree will be published in the March issue of Inter Nos. The Mass texts in English and French will be forwarded to Pastors and Parishes when they have been received. The obligatory Memorial is to be observed annually on the Monday after Pentecost Sunday.

**CANON SUSAN BELL** was elected Coadjutor Bishop of the Anglican Diocese of Niagara, last Saturday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, succeeding Bishop Michael Bird. She will become the 12<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Niagara, in June, the first woman to hold the position since the Diocese was founded in 1875. The electoral Synod, convened at Christ's Church Cathedral in Hamilton, elected Canon Bell on the fifth ballot. We offer our prayers and good wishes.
