HOLY WEEK BEGINS WITH THE PALM SUNDAY CELEBRATIONS! Holy Week precedes the great Feast of the Resurrection on Easter Sunday! It includes the last days of Lent and the beginning of the Easter Triduum (Thursday of the Lord's Supper, Friday of the Passion, and Holy Saturday). The Easter celebrations begin in the darkness of Saturday evening with the Easter Vigil – "the mother of all vigils", according to St. Augustine! May these holiest of days draw us all closer to the Lord and to one another!

A PAUSE IN THE CELEBRATIONS OF CONFIRMATION over Holy Week! We pick up again during Easter week with celebrations at St. John the Baptist Parish, Hamilton, St. Basil Parish, Brantford, and St. James Parish, Oakville. A blessed time for the Confirmandi – and for the Church celebrating the Risen Lord!

THE MASS OF CHRISM is celebrated on Monday evening in the Diocese of Hamilton. It begins at 7:00 p.m. at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King, and is presided over by the Bishop and concelebrated by Priests from all parts of the Diocese. More than any other Mass in the liturgical year, it is a sign of the unity and communion of the Priests with their Bishop. The celebration fosters the relationship of the Bishop with the liturgical life of the Parishes. At this Mass, the Priests renew their Priestly promises. A special thank you to Father David Wynen, Rector of the Cathedral Basilica, and to the team who worked with him to assure that all is well prepared for the event!

FOUR SEMINARIANS HAVE BEEN CALLED TO THE ORDER OF DEACON for the Diocese of Hamilton.
