FIREFIGHTERS IN FULL GEAR interrupted the singing of the *Exultet* during the Easter Vigil at St. Joseph Parish, Hamilton. They were responding to fire alarms that wailed in response to the Easter fire in the sanctuary that got out of control! Parishioners watched in horror until the fire was doused with a pitcher of tap water. The firefighters left when they were sure things were safe, leaving the cantor to complete the *Exultet* and parishioners to celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord. In 43 years of presiding at the Easter Vigil, this was the first "out-of-control" Easter fire for Father Jim Link!
