THE THIRTIETH WORLD DAY OF THE SICK is today. As is the custom, Pope Francis choses a theme for the day and publishes a message in which he reflects on that theme. In our prayer today, we remember especially those who, over the past many months, have suffered with COVID, and for those who have tirelessly cared for them. We also remember all those who are sick in any way, and their caregivers! We pray to the Lord.

THE DIOCESAN PERSONNEL BOARD met earlier this week to consider possible priest personnel changes for 2022. Interviews with priests will begin in the coming days with the publication of changes expected in early April. SELECTED BISHOPS FROM CANADA, THE UNITED STATES AND LATIN AMERICA met by video conference on February 7-8, 2022, for the meeting of the *Church in America*. Held every second year, the meeting was hosted this year by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. The meeting aims to foster relations and discussions between the Bishops of America. THE ONTARIO STATE BOARD of the Knights of Columbus meets this weekend under the direction of State Deputy Marcel Lemmen. The meeting provides the State Board with an overview of the activities of councils across the Province and is a preparation for the 119th Ontario State Convention scheduled to take place in Niagara Falls, April 22-24, 2022. We are grateful for the many good works of the Knights in our Diocese.

LECTURES IN CATHOLIC EXPERIENCE at St. Jerome's University offers a lecture by Waterloo University Professor Mark Jeurgensmeyer titled "What the Taliban and QAnon Have in Common: The Global Rise of Religious Nationalism". The lecture will be online next Wednesday, February 16, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. It is co-sponsored by the Canadian Network for Research on Terrorism, Security and Society (TSAS) at the University of Waterloo.

NEXT THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2022, is the 196th anniversary of the approval of the *Constitutions and Rules* of the Congregation of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate. It was at that time that the young congregation was dedicated to Mary Immaculate. We pray for the Oblate community world-wide, and for those members who serve in the Diocese of Hamilton.
