Let them enjoy the gifts of nature and the fruits of their labours.

Bring them light in time of darkness, health in time of sickness, joy in time of sorrow.

Teach them to listen to your voice, to live in your ways, and to be brothers and sisters of all.

Great Spirit, our God, listen to our prayer, for you rule the universe forever and ever. Amen.
