**POPE BENEDICT XVI ANNOUNCED THIS WEEK THAT** Bishop Richard Malone was appointed as Bishop of Buffalo, NY, succeeding Bishop Edward Kmiec, whose resignation was accepted in the same announcement. THE ASSEMBLY OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS IN ONTARIO (ACBO) has submitted a brief to the Social Policy Committee receiving comments on Bill 13 and Bill 14 currently proposed for legislation by the Ontario Government. Additionally, Cardinal Thomas Collins held a media conference during the week to explain and clarify the concerns of the Bishops. He is the spokesperson for the Ontario Bishops on this matter.
