Nallely Enriquez-Colin and her family were ordered back to Mexico by Immigration Canada effective today. A letter-writing campaign encouraging the Minister to stay the deportation until the completion of the appeal process was ineffective. Mr. Michael MacPherson, the school Principal, emphasizes the Christian virtue of hope which provides some consolation and reassurance for the students.

**CONGRATULATIONS TO SHARON FAZARI AND THE DIOCESAN CHOIR** for the success of their annual Advent Hymn Festival held at St. Raphael Parish, Burlington, last Sunday evening.
