My mother and father were the first couple married in the new church in 1948. Our family moved from Marathon in 1965. I returned to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving as a newly ordained Priest in 1975, and again in the Jubilee Year 2000, to pray at the baptismal font for those who nurtured my faith.
