THE RITE OF ELECTION takes place this Sunday afternoon at 1:30 p.m. at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King in Hamilton, and at the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate in Guelph. The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy of the Second Vatican Council decreed, "The catechumenate for adults, comprising several distinct steps, is to be restored and brought into use at the discretion of the local ordinary. By this means the time of the catechumenate, which is intended as a period of suitable instruction, may be sanctified by sacred rites to be celebrated at successive intervals of time" (#64). The Rite of Election closes the period of the catechumenate. At this rite, upon the testimony of sponsors and catechists and the catechumens' affirmation of their intention to join the Church, the Church makes its "election" of these catechumens to receive the Sacraments of initiation. In the presence of the Bishop, they inscribe their names in the Book of the Elect as a pledge of fidelity. They then begin the final, intense preparation for the reception of the Sacraments at Easter. If you have never participated in the Rite of Election, you are welcome to join us at one or other venue. We pray for those who are making such a life-changing choice!
