John McGovern, (Victoria Cross) in an article published in *Catholic Cemetery*, earlier this month. McGovern is one of 53 Victoria Cross recipients buried in Canada. On November 11th, 40 family members from Chicago returned to Holy Sepulchre Cemetery in Burlington for a commemorative service at McGovern's grave. On Sunday, December 8th, the Pope will celebrate Mass with the new Cardinals at St. Peter's Basilica. The Cardinal's father, who left Italy in 1953 and emigrated to Canada will return to Rome with his son to witness the events, and to return to his family home for the first time since his departure.
